BLUES GREAT KEB' MO' APPEARS IN A SOLO EVENING AT PARKER PLAYHOUSE

FORT LAUDERDALE – Featuring a musician who has inspired guitar makers to issue guitars bearing his name, **A Solo Evening with Keb' Mo'** comes to Parker Playhouse on **Friday, June 15 at 8 p.m.**

Keb' Mo' picked up his fourth Grammy® Award in February for his collaboration with Taj Mahal, *TajMo*. He has received 11 Grammy nominations in total and taken home 11 Blues Foundation Awards including a recent award as Best Contemporary Blues Male Artist.

His 14 albums defy typical genre labels from blues, to country to Americana. He co-wrote "I Hope" with The Dixie Chicks and he has collaborated with numerous artists including Bonnie Raitt, Vince Gill, Amy Grant, Jackson Browne, Natalie Cole, Lyle Lovett, India Arie, James Cotton, Bobby Rush, Timothy B. Schmit, Marcus Miller and many more. Artists who have recorded his songs include B.B. King, Buddy Guy, Joe Cocker, Robert Palmer, Tom Jones, Melissa Manchester and Solomon Burke.

Keb' Mo' was cast to portray the King of the Delta Blues Robert Johnson in the 1998 documentary *Can't You Hear The Wind Howl*. In recognition of his own legacy, Gibson Brands has issued the Keb' Mo' Signature Bluesmaster and Bluesmaster Royale acoustic guitars and Martin Guitars issued the HD-28KM Keb' Mo' Limited Edition Signature model.
