TWO-TIME GRAMMY AWARD® WINNERS CHANTICLEER BRINGS ITS SELF-DESCRIBED ORCHESTRA OF VOICES TO PARKER PLAYHOUSE

FORT LAUDERDALE – Labeled "the world's reigning male chorus" by *The New Yorker*, Chanticleer performs at Parker Playhouse on Friday, January 26 at 8 p.m.

An ensemble of twelve male voices ranging from countertenor to bass that is best described as "an orchestra of voices," Chanticleer performs a program entitled *Heart of a Soldier*, expressing the varied emotions felt by soldiers during times of both war and peace.

The performance features traditional music by Glinka, new works by Mason Bates and John Musto, celebrated choruses from Cold Mountain and other important choral works.

A two-time Grammy Award® winner, Chanticleer became known first for its interpretations of Renaissance music, and was later a pioneer in the revival of the Southern American baroque, recording several award-winning titles in that repertoire. Chanticleer was named Ensemble of the Year by Musical America in 2008, and inducted in the American Classical Music Hall of Fame the same year.

This performance is funded, in part, by a grant from South Arts in partnership with the National Endowment for the Arts and the Florida Division of Cultural Affairs.
