The target audience for this group is community leaders between the ages of 25–45. The Ghost Light Society offers a variety of exclusive benefits for members, including access to pre-sale tickets, pre-show cocktail receptions, specialized networking events and behind-the-scenes educational opportunities throughout the year.

Ghost Light Society memberships are tax-deductible donations to the Broward Performing Arts Foundation and help further the mission of the Broward Center for the Performing Arts. All dollars raised by the Ghost Light Society, including membership dues, go directly to fund the Broward Center’s wide variety of arts-in-education programs that integrate live theater experiences in the teaching process and inspire children to learn, such as *Student Enrichment in the Arts*, which brings more than 150,000 K–12 students each year to see educational and cultural performances at Broward Center venues; and *Reading Readiness Through the Theater*, which utilizes literature-based performances, role-playing and other arts-based early learning techniques to help prepare underserved Head Start students to enter kindergarten ready to read.
