- Grilled vine-ripened tomato and fresh mozzarella with aged balsamic syrup, classic pesto, romesco glaze and grilled toast points
- Beef carpaccio, fresh arugula, shaved fennel, crispy capers, fennel jam, olive oil infusion
- Grilled churrasco steak, chimichurri aioli, chipotle maize cakes with black bean and corn salsa
