Many of these stories have also been adapted for stage and screen, including the 1971 film classic *Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory*, Wes Anderson's acclaimed *Fantastic Mr Fox*, and the Royal Shakespeare Company's multi-award winning production of *Matilda The Musical*.

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
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
